

## First Time Visiting/Training Rules For Yelm Field

Dog must be healthy and cleared for training. Dog must be 16 weeks of age or older with shots UTD including flea and parasite free at all times while training with us. Proof of Vaccination is required.

### What We Expect of You:

**Parking:** Please park along the fence line facing the street until full then other accommodations will be provided (left of gate when you enter field)

#### **Training Field is not a Dog Park:**

- Dogs are to remain on leash at all times unless otherwise instructed.
- Dogs are here to train. If your dog is not actively training it is to be crated. Do “Dog Park” activities at an actual Dog Park or before or after training in the back 5 acres, not during training.
- Please crate your dog in your car, or out beside your car.

**There are Designated Potty Area's.** Please use them. in front before you enter the field on the grass strip is one potty area and out back through the back 12' gate is the other area. Potty your dog(s) appropriately (on leash, upon arrival and as needed). Please clean up after your dog. IF you violate this policy (your dog potties on the field) there is a \$5.00 fine to be paid into the field fund immediately.

**Equipment:** We require the following basic training equipment to get you started (We have the below equipment available for sale if you need it):

- A 4' and 6 - 8 foot quality agitation leash.
- A flat collar, a slip or pinch collar is also recommended. A harness for agitation is not required but is handy for young dogs.
- Toys (If you use a ball on a string, it's good to have 2 identical ones and a tug toy are both recommended)

There is little shade (one small carport canopy). Be sure and bring shade for yourself and your dog (EZ-up, tarp for car, etc.)

Bring a folding chair for your own comfort in between training exercises as we have no seating.

Please bring water for your dog, it can get hot and your dog will need to drink after working.
